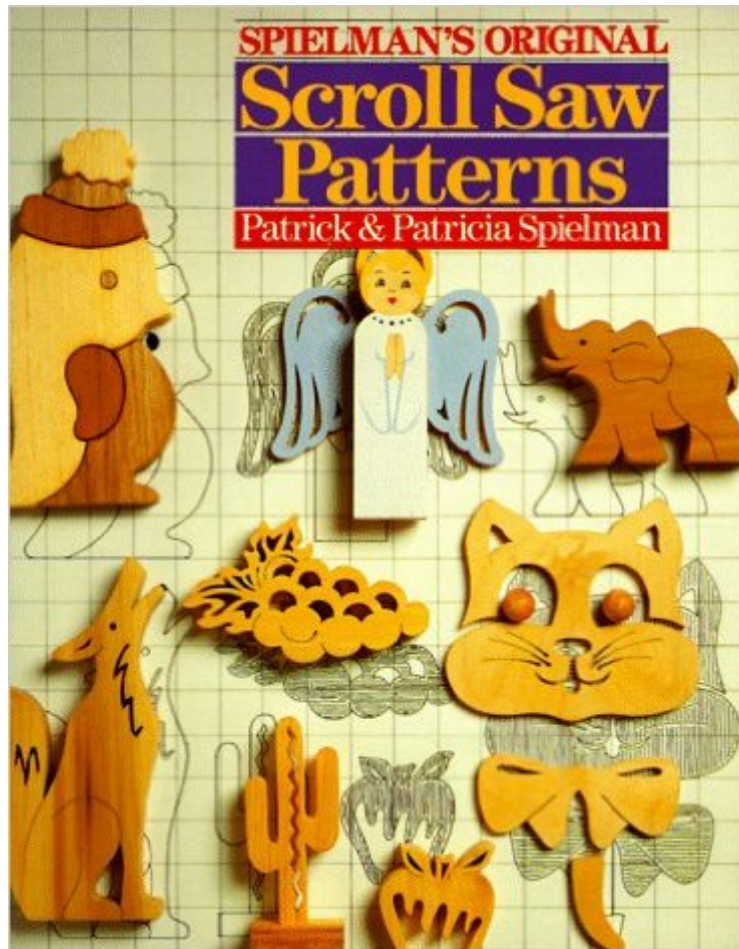

This book is an excellent beginner scroll saw pattern book. It's 224 pages are packed with various patterns and ideas for the beginner. The patterns are not complex, but they are very attractive for being so simple. Most have a few inside cuts add some definition to the project. The Spielman's also take a simple penguin design, and show various ways to "alter" the pattern to create a totally different looking design, and the user is fully accompanied with both words and pictures. This is my 12 year olds favorite book. He took it to school one day, and came home with over 30 different 'orders' from his friends, from cats to coyotes to ducks to hanging mobiles, this book has given him the confidence in scroll sawing. The kids are now picking out their 'birthday' presents that they want my son to make for them, and he has the confidence with this book to do it and be successful.
